#### Pope's Message

Dear Brothers and Sisters, Merry Christmas!

The eyes and the hearts of Christians throughout the world turn



to Bethlehem; in these days, it is a place of sorrow and silence, yet it was there that the long-awaited message was first proclaimed: "To you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, who is Christ the Lord" (Lk 2:11). Those words spoken by the angel in the heavens above Bethlehem are also spoken to us. We are full of hope and trust as we realize that the Lord has been born for us; that the eternal Word of the Father, the infinite God, has made his home among us. He became flesh; he came "to dwell among us" (Jn 1:14). This is the good news that changed the course of history!

The message of Bethlehem is indeed "good news of great joy" (Lk 2:10). What kind of joy? Not the passing happiness of this world, not the glee of entertainment but a joy that is "great" because it makes us great. For today, all of us, with all our shortcomings, embrace the sure promise of an unprecedented gift: the hope of being born for heaven. Yes, Jesus our brother has come to make his Father our Father; a small child, he reveals to us the tender love of God, and much more. He, the Only-Begotten Son of the Father, gives us "power to become children of God" (Jn 1:12). This is the joy that consoles hearts,

renews hope and bestows peace. It is the joy of the Holy Spirit: the joy born of being God's beloved sons and daughters.

Brothers and sisters, today in Bethlehem, amid the deep shadows covering the land, an undying flame has been lighted. Today the world's darkness has been overcome by the light of God, which "enlightens every man and woman" (Jn 1:9). Brothers and sisters, let us exult in this gift of grace! Rejoice, you who have lost confidence in your certitudes, for you are not alone: Christ is born for you! Rejoice, you who have abandoned all hope, for God offers you his outstretched hand; he does not point a finger at you, but offers you his little baby hand, in order to set you free from your fears, to relieve you of your burdens and to show you that, in his eyes, you are more valuable than anything else. Rejoice, you who find no peace of heart, for the ancient prophecy of Isaiah has been fulfilled for your sake: "a child has been born for us, a son given to us, and he is named... Prince of Peace" (9:6). Scripture reveals that his peace, his kingdom, "will have no end" (9:7).

In the Scriptures, the Prince of Peace is opposed by the "Prince of this world" (Jn 12:31), who, by sowing the seeds of death, plots against the Lord, "the lover of life" (cf. Wis 11:26). We see this played out in Bethlehem, where the birth of the Saviour is followed by the slaughter of the innocents. How many innocents are being slaughtered in our world! In their mothers' wombs, in odysseys undertaken in desperation and in search of hope, in the lives of all those little ones whose childhood has been devastated by war. They are the little Jesuses of today, these little ones whose childhood has been devastated by war.

To say "yes" to the Prince of Peace, then, means saying "no" to war, to every war and to do so with courage, to the very mindset of war, an aimless voyage, a defeat without victors, an inexcusable folly. This is what war is: an aimless voyage, a defeat without victors, an inexcusable folly. To say "no" to war means saying "no" to weaponry. The human heart is weak and impulsive; if we find instruments of death in our hands, sooner or later we will use them. And how can we even speak of peace, when arms production, sales and trade are on the rise? Today, as at the time of Herod, the evil that opposes God's light hatches its plots in the shadows of hypocrisy and concealment. How much violence and killing takes place amid deafening silence, unbeknownst to many! People, who desire not weapons but bread, who struggle to make ends meet and desire only peace, have no idea how many public funds are being spent on arms. Yet that is something they ought to know! It should be talked about and written about, so as to bring to light the interests and the profits that move the puppet-strings of war.

Isaiah, who prophesied the Prince of Peace, looked forward to a day when "nation shall not lift up sword against nation", a day when men "will not learn war any more", but instead "beat their swords into ploughshares, and their spears into pruning hooks" (2:4). With God's help, let us make every effort to work for the coming of that day!

May it come in Israel and Palestine, where war is devastating the lives of those peoples. I embrace them all, particularly the Christian communities of Gaza, the parish of Gaza, and the entire Holy Land. My heart grieves for the victims of the abominable attack of 7 October last, and I reiterate my urgent appeal for the liberation of those still being held hostage. I plead for an end to the military operations with their appalling harvest of innocent civilian victims, and call for a solution to the desperate humanitarian situation by an opening to the provision of humanitarian aid. May there be an end to the fueling of violence and hatred. And may the Palestinian question come to be resolved through sincere and persevering dialogue between the parties, sustained by strong political will and the support of the international community. Brothers and sisters, let us pray for peace in Palestine and in Israel.

My thoughts turn likewise to the people of war-torn Syria, and to those of long-suffering Yemen. I think too of the beloved Lebanese people, and I pray that political and social stability will soon be attained.

Contemplating the Baby Jesus, I implore peace for Ukraine. Let us renew our spiritual and human closeness to its embattled people, so that through the support of each of us, they may feel the concrete reality of God's love.

May the day of definitive peace between Armenia and Azerbaijan draw near. May it be advanced by the pursuit of humanitarian initiatives, by the return of refugees to their homes in legality and security, and by reciprocal respect for religious traditions and the places of worship of each community.

Let us not forget the tensions and conflicts that trouble the region of the Sahel, the Horn of Africa and Sudan, as well as Cameroon, the Democratic Republic of the Congo and South Sudan.

May the day draw near when fraternal bonds will be consolidated on the Korean peninsula by undertaking processes of dialogue and reconciliation capable of creating the conditions for lasting peace.

May the Son of God, who became a lowly Child, inspire political authorities and all persons of good will in the Americas to devise suitable ways to resolve social and political conflicts, to combat forms of poverty that offend the dignity of persons, to reduce inequality and to address the troubling phenomenon of migration movements.

From the manger, the Child Jesus asks us to be the voice of those who have no voice. The voice of the innocent children who have died for lack of bread and water; the voice of those who cannot find work or who have lost their jobs; the voice of those forced to flee their lands in search of a better future, risking their lives in grueling journeys and prey to unscrupulous traffickers.

Brothers and sisters, we are approaching the season of grace and hope that is the Jubilee, due to begin a year from now. May this time of preparation for the Holy Year be an opportunity for the conversion of hearts, for the rejection of war and the embrace of peace, and for joyfully responding to the Lord's call, in the words of Isaiah's prophecy, "to bring good news to the oppressed, to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to

the captives, and release to the prisoners" (61:1).

Those words were fulfilled in Jesus (cf. Lk 4:18), who is born today in Bethlehem. Let us welcome him! Let us open our hearts to him, who is the Saviour, the Prince of Peace!

#### COIMBATORE FIDES EDUCATION TRUST

Dear Rev. Fathers.

This year (2024) "Coimbatore Fides Education Trust" has disbursed a sum of Rs. 10,98,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh Ninety Eight Thousand Only) as scholarship. Out of 355 applications received, after careful verification and checking, 262 applications were approved and 93 were rejected. Majority of rejections were due to, not attaching the necessary documents and not securing 50% of marks in each subject. Very few over the income of the parents. The awardees consist of 84 boys and 178 girls from 46 parishes.

#### **Bible Commission**

On Sunday morning, 30th October, 2024, Bible Sunday was celebrated grandly at the Church of St. John De Britto, R. S. Puram. The procession began from the Sacristy with the kids who were dressed up in different Biblical characters, carrying the Holy Bible. Fr. C. Lawrence presided the Holy Mass. In his homily, he spoke about six-fold characteristics of the Word of God, that is, Word of God as Creative, Word of God as Life-Giving, Word of God as Healing, Word of God as Comfort and Consolation, Word of God as Forgiving Sins and Word of God offering Eternal Life. After the Holy Mass, the Mega Bible Museum was opened to the faithful. Besides Our Lady of Lourdes and Our Lady of Fatima, Four mysteries of Faith, namely the Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries were vividly presented by the Catechism Students. The Bible Museum was fabulous, creative, inspiring and informative. Congratulations to Rev. Fr. A. Thadeus Paulrai. Bro. Praveen Fernando, Catechism Teachers, Students, and the Parishioners.

On Sunday evening, 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2024, Bible Sunday was celebrated grandly at the Church of St. Thomas, Avinashi. The procession began with the kids dressed up in different Biblical characters, carrying the Holy Bible. Fr. C. Lawrence presided the Holy Mass and, in his homily, he enumerated the importance and significance of the Word of God. He also exhorted the faithful to read, reflect and live the Word of God. After the Holy Mass, Mega Bible Cultural Fest was conducted.

12 Anbiams presented the Biblical themes and Biblical Characters through Songs, Villupattu, Drama and Dance. They vividly presented the story of Prophets Elijah, Samuel and John the Baptist, Miracles of Jesus, and Seven Sacraments. The Bible Mega Cultural Fest ended with the distribution of Prizes to the Participants and Winners. One could see the zeal and enthusiasm of the faithful of this parish. Congratulations to Rev. Fr. Maria Joseph, FMM Sisters, Catechism Teachers, Students, Members of Anbiams, and the Parishioners.

Bible Commission is pleased to inform that the Sixth Class of the Sixth Cycle of Certificate course was conducted on 24th November, 2024 at Jeeva Jyothi Ashram, Bishop's House, Coimbatore. There were more than 100 participants. Fr. C. Lawrence conducted all four sessions. He initiated the first session with questions to raise curiosity in the mind of the participants. He gave a detailed introduction on the Book of Revelation, mentioning, Apocalyptical Literary Genre, Roman Empire and Emperor Worship, and the Seven Churches in Asia Minor (Modern Turkey). He also explained the Book of Revelation as a Drama, having Director as the Heavenly Father, Jesus as the Hero, the Story as Life of Suffering Christian, John as the Script Writer, Angels as the Companions of Hero, The Suffering Church as Heroine, Satan as Villain and Roman Emperor and Officials as Companions of Villain. He also explained the use of Symbols and their significance in the Book of Revelation. He explained the first five chapter of the Book of Revelation word by word and sentence by sentence. He clarified the following phrases and concepts: "things that must soon take place" "The Seven Spirits" "The Seven Churches in Asia" "Behold, He is coming with the clouds" "Scroll" "Seven Golden Lamp Stands" "Seven Stars" "Nicolaitans" "Throne of Satan" "Key of David" "I am coming soon" "Throne" "Seven Seals" "they sang a new song" etc. One could see the zeal, enthusiasm and thirst of the participants. Finally, Fr. C. Lawrence responded to the participants' queries.

#### News from CMSSS

Dear Fathers and Sisters,

#### GREETINGS FROM CMSSS ASER

For this year, the ASER education survey was taken over by the CMSSS. The purpose of the survey is to learn more about Indian children's educational standing. It is a nationwide poll conducted across the nation. To determine if Indian children receive a quality education, the survey will assess the school and the children's surroundings. This poll will be used to determine the challenges faced by the kids. In and around Coimbatore district; the survey was successfully finished. It took around a month to complete this work. The ASER has received the completed copy. Twenty members of our society volunteered to conduct the survey, which was conducted in thirty villages. The volunteers worked really hard to accomplish this enormous task. I would like to thank all of the CMSSS volunteers, field coordinators, and partner organizations for making this effort possible.

We conducted a session with St. Michael's Cathedral catechism students ranging in grade ninth to twelfth. The event was held in the morning of November 10th. There were about forty students who took part, and the catechism professors were also there. The duration of the lesson was approximately one hour. 'Learning techniques' and exam preparation are the topics of the session. They were introduced to about eight different learning strategies and given instructions on how to realistically incorporate them into their academic lives. The director conducted the session. The learning materials were demonstrated using PowerPoint and a few IEC publications. The pupils voiced their concerns and they were answered. I express my gratitude to the Cathedral parish priests and the catechism coordinators for organizing the event.

#### MOTIVATIONAL AND FINANCIAL INPUTS TO WSHGS

On November 20, 2024, we met with the three WSHGs in the Pollachi region. The purpose of the gathering was to increase women's power in their respective lives. The women were inspired to understand and confront the difficulties they encounter at home or at work. The session lasted for one hour. They learned about the contemporary issues and how they affect people and relationships.

They also received numerous recommendations on how to solve their issues. They had time to discuss their issues and were provided some strategies for comprehending and addressing them. They were given the concepts and methods for solving problems so they could deal with the circumstances on their own. I express my gratitude to Mrs. Jayanthi, the coordinator, for arranging the women for the program.

Likewise, we had another session with the Kinathukadavu region's WSHGs on the same day. There were about fifty participants in the program. The duration of the session was one hour. The impact of contemporary difficulties in their homes was emphasized during the workshop. How do the difficulties impact relationships and family life? What strategic planning techniques might they employ to meet these contemporary challenges? After talking about their financial issues, they were told to keep the interest rates in the





account separate. The group will be at risk of not understanding the financial statement at the end of each year if interest rates and internal loans are combined. They were instructed to use the real-world examples to address the problem in their groups right away. I applaud the participants and the coordinator for putting the program together. They engaged and asked many questions to get their questions answered. The director took the session. I express my gratitude to Mrs. Elizabeth Victoria, the coordinator, for arranging the women for the program.

#### ECOLOGICAL APPROACH SESSION

A meeting was held with the parents and pupils of St. John Bosco School. The topic of the discussion was environmental changes and their negative impacts. A meeting was scheduled with the Win Kolping and Peter Kolping families at Rathinapuri on November 19. The coordinator and the director met with the group. The group received training on gender equality and how to apply it to their everyday lives. An hour





was spent in the meeting. The director conducted the discussion, followed by a group discussion to learn about the differences and

how to deal with them in our personal or professional lives. During the session, the challenges were discussed. They were provided some strategies and recommendations on how to deal with the challenges they face in life. The representatives' session proceeded smoothly. I would like to express my gratitude to everyone who attended the meeting.



#### MOTIVATIONAL TRAININGS ON SOCIAL FORESTRY

We gave two lectures on ecological approaches to the Kolping households in the Kinathukadavu and Pollachi regions, as well as social forestry. The program's focus was on the preservation and expansion of the environment. Various sub-themes pertaining to the advantages and disadvantages of the environment were presented to them. Emphasis was placed on each person's duty to comprehend the importance of the ecological system. There were between fifty to sixty participants in this session. Flyers about environmental awareness were given to them. They distributed some flyers to the local population. I would like to express my gratitude to all of the attendees as well as the coordinators that organized the event.



#### COMMISSION FOR SC/ST

We commemorated Dalit Liberation Sunday at the Cathedral on November 10. The Dalit Christians' social acceptability and empowerment were the main themes of the day's liturgy. In addition to intercession for the unique needs of the Dalit Christians, there was a special liturgy. To mark the liturgy for the day, a flex was put on display for the parishioners to see. All of the diocese's parishes received the posters and the liturgy. In their Sunday liturgies, a few parishes observed the liturgy. I express my gratitude to the parish priests who made the effort to celebrate that day's special liturgy.

#### COIMBATORE DIOCESE HEALTH COMMISSION (CDHC)

We held a drug awareness program at St. John Bosco School in Goundampalayam on November 9th, with approximately 150 students from 10th to 12th grade. The program lasted an hour, and the principal and teachers enthusiastically participated as well. The session was led by the director and focused on the importance of education and how drugs affect a person's educational journey. Students answered questions, the negative effects of drugs were explained to them, the PPT was used to understand the scenario of drug use among the youth, and the after effects of the drugs were shown to them through pictures and the video. The students were also motivated to dream high and to achieve their ambitions amidst the hurdles. I thank the school Principal Fr. Pitchai Robert who took initiative to hold this program at the school and the staff for coordinating the program.

#### MENTALHEALTH PROGRAM:

Another mental health event for the parents and teachers of St. John Bosco School in Goundampalyam was held on the same day. Assisted by two staff members, the director oversaw the program. The program emphasized the influence of childhood and its ramifications for later life. The entire life stages of a person will be explained in the program. Through this program, parents and educators will gain a better understanding of their children's behavioral patterns. However, understanding oneself will also be



beneficial. In the morning, the session lasted for an hour. They had time to voice any questions they had about the session at

the end, and those questions were answered. I express my gratitude to the principal, Fr. Pitchai Robert, who took part in the presentation as well, for organizing this beneficial event for the teachers and parents.

We held drug awareness events in Kinathukadavu and Pollachi. There were about fifty persons in each area. The topic of drug use in society was discussed for an hour. They were concerned about what was going on among the schoolchildren. Examples and explanations of the different effects of drug usage at a young age were provided to them. They learned how to track down pupils or their kids who are abusing narcotics.

They were offered a lot more ideas as parents to help them comprehend their kids' issues on this matter. They were



shown by the contemporary issues of drugs and their ability to alter a person's character. They received a lot more ideas to help them think about their own lives. They were getting their questions about these matters answered. Their questions were addressed. We ran a campaign to draw attention to drug misuse by displaying placards. They enthusiastically took part and swore to raise awareness and regulate their children in their communities.


