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## Pope's Message

Dear brothers and sisters!

Thank you very much  
for your words!

Three things that you  
said struck me: "armchair  
critics," "comfort zone," and  
"technology" – the duty to use it but also  
the risks involved. This is the speech that I  
had prepared, but now I will speak!

Young people are courageous and like  
to seek the truth but they have to be careful  
not to become what you referred to as  
"armchair critics" with endless words. A  
young person must be a critical thinker,  
and it is not good never to be critical. But  
you must be constructive in criticism,  
because there is a destructive criticism,  
which only makes a lot of complaints but  
does not offer a new way forward. I ask all  
young people, each of you: are you critical  
thinkers? Do you have the courage to  
criticize but also the courage to let others  
criticize you? Because, if you criticize,  
then someone else will criticize you. This  
is sincere dialogue between young people.

Young people must have the courage to  
build, to move forward and go out of their  
"comfort zones". A young person who  
chooses always to spend his or her time in  
"comfort" is a young person who becomes  
fat! Not fatter in body, but fatter in mind!  
That is why I say to young people, "Take  
risks, go out! Do not be afraid!". Fear is a  
dictatorial attitude that paralyzes you. It is  
true that young people often make



mistakes, many mistakes, and it would be good if each one of us – if each of you – could think about how many times you have made mistakes. We make mistakes because we started walking and we make mistakes on the journey. This is normal; the important thing to realize is that you have made mistakes. Let us see who can answer my question: What is worse, making a mistake because I started to walk or not making a mistake because I stayed at home? Everyone, the latter! A young person who does not take risks, who is afraid of making mistakes, is already old! Do you understand this?

You have also talked about the media. Today there are so many options, so many possibilities for using the media, cell phone, or television. I would like to ask you: is it good to use media or is it not good? Let us think about this. What is a young person who does not use media like? He or she is closed. What about young people who live totally enslaved to the media, what are they like? They are lost. All young people should use the media, but in a manner that can help us move forward, not in a way that can enslave us. Understood? Do you agree or disagree?

One of the things that has impressed me most about the young people here is your capacity for interfaith dialogue. This is very important because if you start arguing, “My religion is more important than yours...,” or “Mine is the true one, yours is not true....,” where does this lead? Somebody answer. [A young person answers, “Destruction”.] That is correct. All religions are paths to God. I will use an analogy, they are like different languages that express the divine. But God is for everyone, and therefore, we are all God's children. “But my God is more important than yours!”. Is this true? There is only one God, and religions are like languages, paths to reach God. Some Sikh, some Muslim, some Hindu, some Christian. Understood? Yet, interfaith dialogue among young people takes courage. The age of youth is the age of courage, but you can misuse this courage to do things that will not help you. Instead, you should have courage to move forward and to dialogue.



One thing that helps a lot with dialogue is respect. I will tell you one thing. I don't know if it happens here, in this city, but in other cities it happens that among young people something bad occurs: bullying. I ask you: who is the bravest to tell me what they think about bullying? [Some young people respond] Thank you! Everyone has provided a definition of bullying but with a different aspect. Whether it is verbal or physical bullying, it is always an aggression. Always. Just think about what happens in schools or children's groups: bullying targets those who are weaker. For example, a disabled boy or girl. Instead, we saw here this beautiful dance with disabled children! Each one of us has our own abilities and limitations. Do we all have abilities? [Answer: "Yes!"] Do we all have some limitations? [Answer: "Yes!"] Even the Pope? Yes, all, all! As we have our limitations, we must respect the disabilities of others. Do you agree? This is important. Why do I say this? Because overcoming these things helps in your interfaith dialogue since it is built upon respect for others. This is very important.

Any further questions? No? I want to thank you and repeat what Raaj told us: to do everything we can so as to maintain a courageous attitude and promote a space where young people can go and dialogue. This is because your dialogue is one that creates a path, and that leads the way forward. If you dialogue as young people, you will also dialogue as adults; you will dialogue as citizens, and as politicians. I would like to tell you something about history: with every dictatorship in history, the first thing it does is to cut off dialogue.

I thank you for these questions, and I am glad to meet you young people, to meet these brave, almost "shameless ones," you are good! My wish is that all of you young people will go forward with hope, and not go backwards! Take risks! Otherwise, you will grow "fatter"! God bless you and pray for me, I do for you.

## Bishop's Message

Dear Rev.Fathers, Religious and People of God,

The month of October is dedicated to Our Lady of Rosary. In this month the Diocese celebrates the feast of Our Lady of Rosary at Karumanthampatti on the 6<sup>th</sup> of this month. The Shrine of Karumanthampatti is a Basilica and it is our diocesan pilgrim centre. The pilgrims have been receiving a lot of miracles through her intercession. Kindly instruct your parishioners to participate in the celebrations of the feast of Our Lady of Rosary. A good catholic who does not know and pray the rosary is hard to imagine. It is a very popular and easy form of prayer in which we contemplate the life of Christ and the mysteries of our redemption. It is a very simple and very rich form of prayer. Mother Mary has repeatedly and warmly recommended the praying of the Rosary. Wherever she appeared, she asked us to recite the rosary. Please instruct your parishioners to recite the rosary in their houses as a family. The families are blessed by God.

The rosary is a biblical prayer as it recalls the events narrated in the Gospel. It is a Christological prayer as it dwells on the birth, manifestation, suffering, death, resurrection and glorification of Christ. The rosary is also very much a Trinitarian prayer. Besides repeating the Lord's prayer and the glory be, it recalls the annunciation that brought the Father's message to Mary, the coming of the Holy Spirit upon her and her becoming mother of the Son who became man. In a nutshell, rosary is a powerful weapon to conquer the plans of the evil forces.

In this month, the Church celebrates Mission Sunday. The Vatican documents say that the Church, by its very nature, is missionary, and we, who are her members, are missionaries. The works of missions are not optional but mandatory and commanded by Jesus Himself. While celebrating the mission Sunday, we have the bounden duty to contribute generously for this noble cause. The collections and donations given by the people are sent to the different parts of the world for missionary

activities. As such, we have the duty to help the poor missions, particularly, the poor churches across the globe. Mission Sunday is an opportunity to show our love, concern, and solidarity with our less fortunate brethren who share our faith through the sacrament of baptism.

Another important event of this month is our annual clergy retreat which is obligatory for the clergy. You cannot be absent for this spiritual renewal. You may request your parishioners to pray so that we do our retreat well. During our retreat, we get ample time for personal prayer. We shall pray for our parishioners and those who have requested our prayers and for those who are in need of our prayers. Above all, we shall pray for one another.

### **Bible Commission**

On Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2024, Bible Class was conducted at the Basilica of Our Lady of Rosary, Karumathampatty. Fr. C. Lawrence clearly explained, Jesus as the only and unique Savior. He clarified the role of Mary in the History of Salvation. He responded to the queries of the participants. Tea and snacks were provided to all the participants. He also gave a detailed explanation regarding the Moral and Theological Virtues. Congratulations to Fr. K. M. C. Arun, Fr. Andrews Arokiaraj and the parishioners.

On Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2024, Bible Class was conducted at the Church of St. Catherine, Tirupur. Fr. C.



Lawrence gave a detailed explanation of Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ in relation to Salvation History. He also enumerated different Charismata, Gifts, and Fruits of the Holy Church with special reference to Galatians and Romans. He also clarified the distinction between the Moral and Theological Virtues. He responded to the questions of the participants. Congratulations to Fr. Arul Jebamalai Raj, Fr. Sagayaraj and the parishioners.

Bible Commission is pleased to inform that the Fourth Class of the Sixth Cycle of Certificate course was conducted on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2024 at Jeeva Jyothi Ashram, Bishop's House, Coimbatore. There were 110 participants. Fr. C. Lawrence conducted all four sessions. He initiated the first session with few questions to raise curiosity in the minds of the participants. He clarified and explained the following concepts: "Image and Likeness of God" "Tree of Life" Tree of Knowledge" "Paradise" and "Heaven" in relation to the Books of Genesis and Revelation and a long introduction to the Book of Psalms, explaining the meaning and significance of different Hebrew and Greek words during the first and second sessions. In the third session, he answered the queries of the people related to the History of Salvation.

In the final session, he gave a detailed enumeration of three settings, namely, Literary Style, Life Situation and Liturgical Background of the Psalms. He also explained about the Fivefold divisions of the Psalms basing on the scientific study done by German scholar Herman Gunkel. He made an exegetical study on the Confidence Psalm 23 and the Penitential Psalm 51. One could see the zeal, enthusiasm and thirst of the participants. Finally, Fr. C. Lawrence responded to the queries of the participants. I extend sincere thanks to the Most Rev. Dr. L. Thomas Aquinas, Bishop of Coimbatore for his continuous prayer and support. My heartfelt thanks to Very Rev. Msgr. John Joseph Stanis, Vicar General, Fr. Antony Jesuraj, Director of Pastoral Centre, and Rev. Fr. J. Antony Selvaraj, the procurator. ### Children sponsorship program

The TNBC Commission for SC/ST held a meeting on the theme 'DO NO HARM' and capacity building for SC/ST Commission Secretaries of the Diocesan offices at Shrine Retreat Center, Poondy.

Most.Rev. Jeevanantham, Chairman " Our Role And Responsibility", Rev. Fr.Nithiya Sagayam OFM Cap, Regional Secretary " Our Psychological Wellbeing ", Rev. Fr. Philominraj, Former NAT'L & Staff SC/ST Secretary, "Life, Vision and Mission of SC/ST Commission ", Mr. Joseph James, Consultant To Misereor " DO NO HARM " and the





Staff, Field Workers and Helpers participated in the program. On behalf of the Coimbatore diocese, Fr. Tellis Roch was a part of the program. The program was beneficial for the upcoming mission in the SC/ST commission. The event took place between August 27th and 29th.



### **Virtual meeting of SC/ST commission**

The SC/ST commission's general body members and executive members met virtually on September 4th, 2024. The virtual meeting was attended by eight members. The meeting was centered around fundraising, member subscriptions, and the division of executive members into vicariates of the diocese. To support the commission's welfare, each person is required to contribute 200 rupees to their subscription. October 1st marks the beginning of its implementation. The executive members from different vicariates will collect the subscription and hand it over to the commission treasurer. The accounts will be maintained under the guidance of the commission secretary. The discussion led to distributing the student scholarships equally to all areas of the diocese. The members asked to have the study materials for the students taken from the parishes and given to the underprivileged kids in the villages. After 45 minutes, the meeting was over.

### **Zoom Meeting:**

A Zoom meeting about leadership principles was held on Wednesday, September 9. The talk delivered by Father Nithiya Sagayam, OFMcap. The talk concentrated on outlining the criteria that must be adhered to and how a leader can develop. The presentation clarified the concept of leadership. The meeting's attendees numbered one hundred. The hour-long presentation took place in the evening from 7.30 to 8.30p.m.

Every second Monday of the month, the commission decided to hold these kinds of input sessions.

### **KOLPING**

At St. Magdalene Church in Karamadai, we held a kolping family formation on September 8. About thirty people showed up for the gathering. They were given an introduction to kolping, its advantages, and how the system worked. Joyful to learn about Kolping, the parishioners were eager to organize a group under Magdalene's name. Nonetheless, we are making other parishioners aware of this. Fr. Shiju expressed a particular curiosity on the genesis of the group. Sincere appreciation to the parish priest.



On September 8, we held a kolping family re-formation at St. Joseph's Church in Ondipudur. The attendance at the event was about seven persons. The benefits of kolping and the operation of the system were explained to them. The members were excited to form a group with a new name as they were aware of the benefits of Kolping. But we are educating other parishioners about the benefits of Kolping and how it will support the families monetarily. The director celebrated mass at St. Joseph's Church in Ondipudur. It encouraged the parishioners to get involved in new organizations. Fr. Patrick indicated a special interest in the group's origins. Thank you so much, parish priest.

Our Kolping group underwent a reformation at St. Joseph's church in Ondipudur on September 15. Twenty or so persons attended the meeting following the eucharistic celebration. The Director spoke in detail on Kolping's procedures and organizational design. The attendees had voiced their concerns and received clarification on their inquiries. A group of about fifteen persons decided to start a new organization and registered their names. As of October, the group has been steadily coming together as a unit. I'd like to thank Fr. Patrick



for his initiative and team support.

We got together with the Ignatius Kolping family at Somanur during the first week of September. The gathering, held on the church grounds, drew about ten attendees. They were addressing their uncertainties about fortifying the group and adhering to the documents. After all of their questions were answered, they were inspired to move quickly to create a vibrant group. It was also recommended that they adequately expand the group by adding new members. The Kolping family's conventions were accepted by both the new and the old members. I would want to thank Fr. John Xavier, the parish priest, for accepting our plea and assisting the group in moving forward. I also like to thank the Kolping family members.

### **COIMBATORE DIOCESE HEALTH COMMISSION (CDHC)**

We held a free medical camp at Kombakaatupudur and the neighboring communities on September 15. Organized by our diocese Health Commission, the camp was effectively run with the assistance of the Ann Sisters of Luzern, Pallapalayam. Approximately 75 individuals participated in the camp and gained advantages. A doctor, four sisters, and a nurse served as the camp's leaders. The camp also provided them a lot of confidence in their ability to recover their health and receive assistance from the sisters and diocese. The R.C. School of Kombakaatupudur was the location of the camp. My heartfelt gratitude goes out to Fr. Diraviam for agreeing to host our camp and allowing us to use the school grounds for it. I am appreciative of his concern for his parishioners' well-being. I would also like to thank the school. My sincere gratitude also





goes out to the head of the school and the personnel that accompanied the camp leaders and looked after the people.

### **Drug Awareness Program**

We held a drug awareness program at Bishop Oubagarasamy School in Kumar Nagar on September 3. An hour was spent on the awareness program. The course was designed to foster feedback and interaction between the students. Approximately two hundred pupils took part and became aware of the prevailing conditions in society. The awareness program helped the pupils become aware of their surroundings. Our group is grateful to Fr. Peter Mariadass and the faculty and staff of the school for their acceptance of our interest and enthusiastic attendance at the program. We appreciate everyone that took part and cooperated with us.

We held our regular Couples in Christ session with the parishioners on September 22nd at the Othakalmandapam parish. A little over fifty people showed up to the meeting eager to learn about the ins and outs of managing a family. The director spoke on how childhood affects people throughout their life. 'Do no harm' is the approach taken in this session on childhood impacts. The session centers on the various phases of an individual's life. The ways in which family members guide a person's development. For forty-five minutes, the session continued. We engaged in conversation with the attendees at the conclusion of the seminar. I am grateful to Fr. Joy for encouraging and supporting the parishioners to participate in this family activity.

On the same day at Othakalmandapam, we met with the youth girls for an additional thirty minutes. They were taught about the prevalence of sexual harassment in families, workplaces, and other social contexts. The program aimed to raise awareness among the girls about the events in their surroundings and provide them with guidance on how to respond appropriately in similar situations. Real-world examples and strategies for avoiding danger were imparted to them. They were also inspired to support and raise awareness of the other female students in the universities, colleges, and



other educational settings. The session was conducted by Sr. Anto, with assistance from Sr. Ponmani. The session included about thirty girls. I thank the sisters who spent their valuable Sunday time for the welfare of the youth
